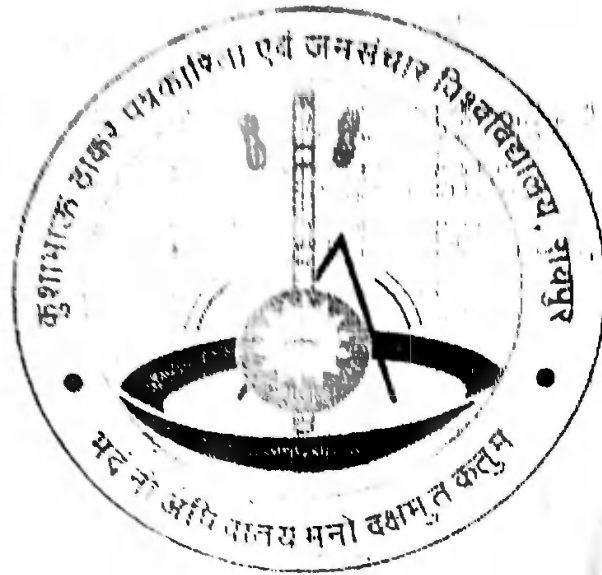

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

ORDINANCE No. 14 (Revised)
(Doctor Of Philosophy (Ph.D) As per UGC Regulation 2022)

DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY (Ph.D.)

Preamble

1. The degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) may be granted in any discipline belonging to any faculty of the Kushabhau Thakre Patrakarita Avam Jansanchar Vishwavidyalaya (hereafter: University); in which post-graduate studies and research is available at the University. All academic matters related to Ph.D. degree shall be called Ph.D. Programme.


1.1 Departmental Research Committee (DRC):

1.1.1 The Departmental Research Committee (DRC) shall be constituted for each department, offering Ph.D. programme of the University, in the following manner:

- i. All teachers of the department who are recognized by the University as Research Supervisors shall be member.
- ii. There shall be at least three members, including the chairman of the DRC.
- iii. The head of the Department shall be chairperson of the DRC.
- iv. The Vice Chancellor shall nominate members from other/related department in case the number of recognized Research Supervisors is less than two in any Department of the University.
- v. All academic matters related to Ph.D. programme shall be processed by the concerned DRC.
- vi. One external subject expert who is not the service of the university and presumably not below the rank of professor shall be nominated by the Vice Chancellor.

1.1.2 This Committee shall have the following responsibilities:

- i. To recognize Research Centers for purpose of conducting Ph.D. programme.

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- ii. To recognize Research Supervisors and Co-Supervisors to guide Research Scholars on the basis of their application in prescribed format. (Appendix-1).
- iii. To approve the notification for inviting application for PhD programme in the prescribed format. (Appendix-2)
- iv. To decide the research topics of Research Scholars.
- v. To register the Research Scholars and cancel the registration if situation so warrants.
- vi. To deliberate upon any other matter related to Research in the concerned faculty of the University, referred to it by the University authorities and take appropriate decisions.
- vii. To receive applications on behalf of the Registrar of the University in prescribed format. (Appendix-3).
- viii. To prepare the list of successful candidates for Ph.D. programme following due procedure as per Clause 3.2 below.
- ix. To allocate the Research Supervisor for Research Scholars as per Clause 4.1.
- x. To prescribe the course(s) to Research Scholars based on the recommendations of the RAC as per Clause 4.1.
- xi. To conduct the evaluation of course work for Research Scholars at the departmental level and communicate the result to the university.
- xii. To deliberate upon any other matter related to Research in the concerned department of the University, either mentioned in the following Clauses or referred to it by the University authorities and take appropriate decisions.

1.2 Research Supervisors/ Co-supervisors

The DRC shall recognize Research Supervisor/Co-supervisor to guide the Research Scholars. A Research Supervisor/Co-supervisor must be:

1.2.1 Permanent faculty members working as Professor/Associate Professor of the Kushabhau Thakre Patrakarita Avam Jansanchar Vishwavidyalaya with a Ph.D., and at least five research publications in peer-reviewed or refereed journals and permanent faculty members working as Assistant Professors in Kushabhau Thakre Patrakarita Avam Jansanchar Vishwavidyalaya with a Ph.D., and at least three research publications in peer-reviewed or refereed journals may be recognized as a Research Supervisor in the university where the faculty member is employed or in its affiliated Post-graduate Colleges/institutes. Such recognized research supervisors cannot supervise research scholars in other institutions, where they can only act as co-supervisors. Ph.D. awarded by a university under

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the supervision of a faculty member who is not an employee of the university or its affiliated Post-graduate Colleges/institutes would be in violation of these Regulations. For Ph.D. scholars working in Central government/ State government research institutions whose degrees are given by Higher Educational Institutions, the scientists in such research institutions who are equivalent to Professor/Associate Professor/Assistant Professor can be recognized as supervisors if they fulfill the above requirements. Provided that in areas/disciplines where there is no, or only a limited number of peer-reviewed or refereed journals, the Higher Educational Institution may relax the above condition for recognition of a person as Research Supervisor with reasons recorded in writing. Co-Supervisors from within the same department or other departments of the same institution or other institutions may be permitted with the approval of the competent authority. Adjunct Faculty members shall not act as Research Supervisors and can only act as co-supervisors.

1.2.2 In case of interdisciplinary/multidisciplinary research work, if required, a Co-Supervisor from outside the Department/School/Centre/College/University may be appointed.


1.2.3 An eligible Professor/Associate Professor/Assistant Professor can guide up to eight (8) / six (6) / four (4) Ph.D. scholars, respectively, at any given time.

1.2.4 In case of relocation of a female Ph.D. scholar due to marriage or otherwise, the research data shall be allowed to be transferred to the Higher Educational Institution to which the scholar intends to relocate, provided all the other conditions in these Regulations are followed, and the research work does not pertain to a project sanctioned to the parent Institution/Supervisor by any funding agency. Such scholar shall, however, give due credit to the parent institution and the supervisor for the part of research already undertaken.

1.2.5 Faculty members with less than three years of service before superannuation shall not be allowed to take new research scholars under their supervision. However, such faculty members can continue to supervise Ph.D. scholars who are already registered until superannuation and as a co-supervisor after superannuation, but not after attaining the age of 70 years.

1.2.6 ~~No~~ Supervisor/Co-Supervisor shall guide a scholar who is in blood relation.


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1.2.7 The term relations shall include but not limited to: Father, Mother, Wife, Husband, Daughter, Son, Grand Son, Grand Daughter, Brother, Sister, Nephew, Niece, Grand Nephew/ Niece, Uncle, Aunt, Son-in-Law, Daughter-in-Law, Father-in-Law, First-cousin-in Law etc.

2. Research Center:

The Departments of the University may be recognized as Research center by the DRC, provided regular faculty members of the concerned department are recognized as Research Supervisors.

3. Research Advisory Committee (RAC) and its functions.

3.1 There shall be a three-member Research Advisory Committee (RAC) among the members of respective department for each Research scholar. The Research Supervisor of the Research Scholar shall be the Convener of this Committee in addition the Co-supervisor shall also be member of the RAC where ever applicable. In case department does not have these regular faculty members (eligible to act or supervisor) with the permissions DRC regular faculty member from sister department/out side university may be opted.

3.2. This Committee shall have the following responsibilities:


3.2.1 To review the research proposal and finalize the topic of research;

3.2.2 To guide the Research Scholar to develop the study design and methodology of research and identify the course(s) that he/she may have to do.


3.2.3 To periodically review and assist in the progress of the research work of the Research Scholar.

3.3 Each semester, a Ph.D. scholar shall appear before the Research Advisory Committee to make a presentation and submit a brief report on the progress of his/her work for evaluation and further guidance. The Research Advisory Committee shall submit its recommendations along with a copy of Ph.D. scholar's progress report to the DRC. A copy of such recommendations shall also be provided to the Ph.D. scholar.

3.4 In case the progress of the Ph.D. scholar is unsatisfactory, the Research Advisory Committee shall record the reasons for the same and suggest corrective measures. If the Ph.D. scholar fails to implement these corrective measures, the Research Advisory Committee may recommend to the DRC, with specific

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reasons, the cancellation of the registration of the Ph.D. scholar from the Ph.D. programme.

4. Eligibility criteria for admission to the Ph.D. Programme-

4.1 The following are eligible to seek admission to the Ph.D. programme:

Candidates who have completed:

4.1.1 A 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever a grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution.

A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time.

Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time.

4.1.2 Candidates who have completed the M.Phil. programme with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational

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institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time.

5. Process of Inviting Application and Admission to the Ph.D. programme

5.1 The University shall

Decide on an annual basis through its DRC, pre-determined and manageable number of candidates to be admitted to Ph.D. programme depending on the number of available Research Supervisors and other academic and physical facilities available, keeping in mind the norms regarding the scholar-teacher ratio, laboratory, library and such other facilities.


Admission to the Ph.D. programme shall be made using the following methods:


5.1.1 Students who qualify for fellowship/scholarship in UGC-NET/UGC-CSIR NET/GATE/CEED and similar National level tests based on an interview.


And/or

5.1.2 There shall be an Entrance Test named Vishwavidyalaya Research Admission Test (VRAT) to be conducted at the University level, followed by an interview for admission for all other students. The Entrance Test syllabus shall consist of 50% of research methodology and 50% shall be subject specific.

5.1.3 Students who have secured minimum 50 % marks in the entrance test are eligible to be called for the interview.

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5.1.4 A relaxation of 5 % marks will be allowed in the entrance examination for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/differently-abled category, Economically Weaker Section (EWS), and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time.

5.1.5 University shall decide the number of eligible students to be called for an interview based on the number of Ph.D. seats available.

5.1.6. In the interview/viva-voce, to be organized by the University the candidates are required to discuss their research interest/area through a presentation before the DRC. The interview/viva-voce shall also consider the following aspects. viz. whether

5.1.6 (i) The candidate possesses the competence for the proposed research;

5.1.6 (ii) The research work can be suitably undertaken at the University;

5.1.6 (iii) The proposed area of research can contribute to new/additional knowledge.


5.1.7 Provided that for the selection of candidates based on the entrance test conducted by the University, a weightage of 70 % for the entrance test and 30 % for the performance in the interview/viva- voce shall be given.

5.2 The University shall:



5.2.1 Notify a prospectus well in advance on the institution's website specifying the number of seats for admission, subject/discipline-wise distribution of available seats, criteria for admission, the procedure for admission, and all other relevant information for the candidates;

5.2.2 Adhere to the state-level reservation policy;

5.2.3 Presumably 50% (fifty percent) seats shall be allotted for to UGC-NET/UGC- CSIR NET/GATE/CEED qualified candidates. In case of non-availability of such candidates, those seats shall be filled by candidates coming through entrance test.

5.3 The University shall maintain a list of Ph.D. supervisors (specifying the name of the supervisor, his or her designation, and the department/school/center), along with the details of Ph.D. scholars (specifying the name of the registered Ph.D. scholar, the topic of his/her research and the date of admission) admitted under them on the website of the institution and update this list every academic year.

5.4. An eligible candidate must apply for admission to the Ph.D. programme of his/her subject at the Research Centre on the prescribed form/online and pay prescribed fee. The application shall be considered by the concerned DRC.

If the seats allotted for SC/ST/OBC(Non Creamy layer)/Differently-abled categories remain unfilled, the university shall launch a Special Admission Drive, for those particular categories. The VRAT shall be conducted at the Centre/s notified in advance. In case seats are vacant after all effort, these may be re-allotted to other categories as per government rules.

5.5 The written test shall be conducted for 100 marks and the interview/PI shall be held for 25 marks.


5.5.1 Interview/PI for the exempted category: 100 marks

5.5.2 Separate merit list for different categories of applicants shall be prepared, to enable the DRC to grant provisional admission, keeping in view the reservation policy of Chhattisgarh as applicable from time to time. However, horizontal reservation shall be applicable for female and EWS categories.


6. **Course Work: Credit requirements, number, duration, syllabus, minimum standards for completion, etc.**

6.1 All eligible candidates shall be required to undertake course work for a minimum period of one semester.

6.2 The DRC shall prescribe the course(s) based on the recommendations of the RAC.

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6.3 The course content shall be designed by the Board of Studies (BoS) of the concerned subject. The course prescribed for Ph.D. course work shall be duly approved by the academic council.

6.4 The Credit requirement for the Ph.D. coursework is a minimum of 12 credits, including a "Research and Publication Ethics" course as notified by UGC vide D.O. No. F.1- 1/2018(Journal/CARE) in 2019 and a research methodology course. The Research Advisory Committee can also recommend UGC recognized online courses as part of the credit requirements for the Ph.D. programme.

6.5 All Ph.D. scholars, irrespective of discipline, shall be required to train in teaching /education /pedagogy/writing related to their chosen Ph.D. subject during their doctoral period. Ph.D. scholars may also be assigned 4-6 hours per week of teaching/research assistantship for conducting tutorial or laboratory work and evaluations.

6.6 A Ph.D. scholar must obtain a minimum of 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the UGC 10-point scale in the course work to be eligible to continue in the programme and submit his or her thesis. In case a scholar fails to obtain 55% or required marks, DRC may allow scholar to appear in next re-examination. Scholar shall be permitted once only to write re-examination.

7. Process of Registration as Research Scholar:


7.1 After successfully completing the course work, the candidate shall be eligible to submit synopsis (as per Appendix-5) of his/her proposed research work, (in six copies) duly forwarded by the chairman of the relevant DRC. He/she shall be required to make an oral presentation of the proposed work before the DRC. The External expert and two other members shall form the quorum of the DRC meeting held for this purpose.

Note:

7.1(i). The Supervisor/ Co-supervisor are entitled to be present during the oral presentation of his/her candidate.

7.1(ii). No. TA and D.A. shall be payable to the candidate and the Supervisor/Co-supervisor for attending the Research Degree Committee meeting.

8. A candidate shall ordinarily be permitted to work for Ph.D. degree in the subject in which he/she has obtained his/her post-graduate degree.

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8.1 Provided that research work leading to Ph.D. degree may be encouraged in allied subjects of interdisciplinary nature of the same faculty or of allied faculties; In such cases the candidate may also be permitted to work under one or two Co-Supervisors, along with the Research Supervisor of the University.

9. A candidate shall pursue his/her research at the Research Centre from where his/her application form has been forwarded:

9.1. Provided that a candidate permitted to work in a Research Center* recognized by the University shall be required to take at least one Co-Supervisor along with the Supervisor; one of them should be the teacher of the University and the other a Teacher/ Scientist/ Research Officer/ Director of the Institution where the candidate is actually working.

*Includes Institutions and Laboratories run and sponsored by the Union /State Governments or its agencies; and foreign university/Institution of repute.

9.2 Provided also, a candidate may be permitted to carry out his/her research/practical work in a Research Institution/ Research Laboratory/ Laboratory of a university recognized by the University for the purpose under the supervision of a Scientist/ Director/ Teacher of the Institution who may or may not be the Co-Supervisor of the candidate.

10. Ph.D. through Part-time Mode-


10.1. Ph.D. programmes through part-time mode may be permitted, provided all the conditions stipulated in these Regulations are fulfilled.


10.2 The Kushabhau Thakre Patrakarita Avam Jansanchar Vishwavidyalaya/ Its research center shall obtain a "No Objection Certificate" from the candidate at the time of admission for a part-time Ph.D. programme from the appropriate authority in the organization where the candidate is employed, clearly stating that:


10.2(i) The candidate is permitted to pursue studies on a part-time basis;

10.2(ii) His/her official duties permit him/her to devote sufficient time for research.

10.2(iii) If required, he/she will be relieved from the duty to complete the course work.

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10.3 Notwithstanding anything contained in these Regulations or any other law for the time being in force. **NO** Higher Educational Institution or research institution of the Central government or a State Government shall conduct Ph.D programmes through **distance and/or online mode.**

11. Tenure of Ph.D. Programme

11.1 Ph.D. program shall be for a minimum of three years from the date of admission to the Ph.D. programme including course work and a maximum of six years.

11.2 A maximum of an additional two (02) years can be given through a process of re-registration; provided, however, that the total period for completion of a Ph.D. programme should not exceed eight (8) years from the date of admission in the Ph.D. programme.

Provided further that, female Ph.D. scholars and Persons with Disabilities (having more than 40% disability) may be allowed an additional relaxation of two (02) years; however, the total period for completion of a Ph.D. programme in such cases should not exceed ten (10) years from the date of admission in the Ph.D. programme.


11.3 Female Ph.D. Scholars may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave for up to 240 days in the entire duration of the Ph.D. programme.

11.4 The candidate shall put in at least 200 days attendance, excluding attendance he/she will earn during the course work, in the research center and certified by the Supervisor and/or Co Supervisor. **Appendix 6**


12. Admission of International students in Ph.D. programme.

12.1 Each supervisor can guide up to two international research scholars on supernumerary basis over and above the permitted number of Ph.D. scholars specified in clause 1.2.3 above.

12.2. The University shall decide its own selection procedure for Ph.D. admission of international students keeping in view the guidelines/norms in this regard issued by statutory/regulatory bodies concerned from time to time.

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12.3. At any point, the total number of Ph.D. scholars under a faculty member, either as a supervisor or a co-supervisor, shall not exceed the number prescribed in clause 1.2.3 and clause 12.1.

13. Change of Supervisor

The Research Scholar may be allowed to change the Research Supervisor by the Vice Chancellor, on the recommendation of the DRC or committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor for this purpose under special circumstances. No major change in the topic of research will be permitted due to change in supervisor.

14. Six-monthly Progress Report

Applicable as per Clause 3.3 above.

15. Submission of Summary of Thesis

15.1 Prior to submission of the thesis, the Research Scholar shall make a pre-Ph.D. presentation before the RAC that shall be open to all faculty members and Research Scholars, for getting feedback and comments, which may be suitably incorporated into the draft thesis under the advice of the Research Supervisor.


15.2 The Research Scholar shall submit six copies of the summary of the thesis together with at least two (02) research paper in refereed journal and two (02) paper presentations in conferences/seminars before the submission of the thesis for adjudication, and produce evidence for the same in the form of presentation of certificates and/or reprints through his/her Research Supervisor to the Registrar about two months prior to the anticipated date of submission of thesis.


15.3 The University shall undertake Plagiarism check using well-developed software applications to detect Plagiarism in research work and the research integrity shall be an integral part of all the research activities leading to the award of a Ph.D. degree.


15.4 A Ph.D. scholar shall submit the thesis for evaluation, along with

15.4.2 A certificate from the Research Supervisor attesting to the originality of the thesis and that the thesis has not been submitted for the

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award of any other degree/diploma to any other Higher Education Institution.

15.5 The Research Supervisor shall submit a panel of at least six names of examiners actively engaged in the concerned area of research and having good academic and research credentials, in a sealed cover to the Registrar/COE.

15.5.1 Provided that the panel of examiners shall be obtained from the Chairman Board of Studies of the Subject concerned, in case the Research Scholar is related to the Research Supervisor.

15.6 On the receipt of the panel of examiners from the Research Supervisor and a summary from the Research Scholar, Chairman, Board of Studies, will submit the same panel to the COE. COE shall place the panel within one week to the Vice Chancellor for approval of two external and one internal examiner. (Supervisor; Co-Supervisor in absence or unavailability of supervisor)

15.7 The Ph.D. thesis submitted by a Ph.D. scholar shall be evaluated by his/his Research Supervisor and at least two external examiners who are experts in the field and not in employment of the Higher Educational Institution concerned. Such examiner(s) should be academics with a good record of scholarly publications in the field. Wherever possible, one of the external examiners should be chosen from outside India. The viva-voce board shall consist of the Research Supervisor and at least one of the two external examiners and may be conducted online. The viva-voce shall be open to the members of the Research Advisory Committee/faculty members/research scholars, and students.

15.8 The viva-voce of the Ph.D. scholar to defend the thesis shall be conducted if both the external examiners recommend acceptance of the thesis after incorporating any corrections suggested by them. If one of the external examiners recommends rejection, the University shall send the thesis to an alternate external examiner from the approved panel of examiners, and the viva-voce examination shall be held only if the alternate examiner recommends acceptance of the thesis. If the alternate examiner does not


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
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
recommend acceptance of the thesis, the thesis shall be rejected, and the Ph.D. scholar shall be declared ineligible for the award of a Ph.D.

15.9 The University shall try to complete the entire process of evaluating a Ph.D. thesis, including the declaration of the viva-voce result, within a period of six (6) months from the date of submission of the thesis.

16. The Research Scholar shall submit five (05) bound copies of his/her thesis along with the following:
- Reprint of the published paper (Ref. 12.2) or acceptance letter and certificate of presentation of the papers in Symposium/Conference/Seminar.
 - The declaration from the Research Scholar that the thesis embodies his/her own work and he/she has worked under the Supervisor at the approved place of work for the required period as per provisions of Clause 11.4 of Ordinance (Appendix-8).
 - The certificate from the Supervisor together with Co-supervisors, if any, that the thesis fulfills the requirements of the Ordinance relating to the Ph.D. degree of the University (Appendix-9).
 - The candidate shall also remit with the thesis the prescribed examination fee.
 - Submission of Electronic copy of the Thesis/ Dissertation (ETD) is mandatory at the time of submission of the Ph.D. thesis. The University shall submit a soft copy to the UGC within a period of 30 days after the award of the degree, for hosting the same in INFLIBNET, accessible to all Institutions /Universities.
 - The DRC shall forward the thesis to the university Anti Plagiarism cell for plagiarism check (Appendix-10) and the candidate will submit a declaration that the thesis is free from plagiarism. (Appendix-11). The Anti Plagiarism Cell of the University shall issue a certificate, within 3 weeks, regarding the authenticity of the thesis in Annexure 11-A. This certificate has to be appended with the Thesis.
 - The submission of a thesis shall create a vacancy for the admission of a new candidate for Ph.D. degree under the concerned Research Supervisor.

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17. **Evaluation Procedures following Submission of the Thesis**

On receipt of the thesis along with the certificates and fee it shall be sent to the examiners already consented as per provisions of the Ordinance.

18. The thesis to be accepted of the award of Ph.D. degree must comply with the following conditions:

- i. It must be a piece of research work characterized either by the discovery of the facts or by a fresh approach towards the interpretation of facts. In either case it should evince the candidate's capacity for critical examination and sound judgment.
- ii. It must be satisfactory in point of language and presentation of the subject matter.

19. The examiners shall categorically recommend in the prescribed proforma (Appendix-12) acceptance, revision or rejection of the thesis together with detailed comments on the points spelled out in Clause 16 of the Ordinance. The examiner must also give a list of the questions he/she wishes to be asked at the viva-voce examination.

20. (i) The examiners may seek clarification of the subject matter of the thesis from the Research Supervisor. The provision will be incorporated in the letter to be sent to the examiners while sending the thesis.

(ii) The Vice Chancellor can recall the thesis from an examiner who fails to send the report within three months of the date of dispatch of the thesis and appoint another examiner.

21. (i) In case both the original examiners accept the thesis for the award of the Ph.D. Degree or in the event of it being referred to the third examiner, the third examiner accepts the thesis for the award of the Ph.D. Degree, the candidate shall be called upon to appear at the viva-voce examination before a board of examiners comprising of the Research Supervisor, Co-Supervisor (if any) and one of the two external examiners who have accepted the thesis for the award of the Ph.D. Degree.

(ii) Provided that the Vice Chancellor may appoint the Chairman, DRC or Chairman, Board of Studies of the subject concerned to act as viva-voce examiner, in place of the Supervisor in case the candidate is related (Clause 12.10) to the Research Supervisor.

(v) The Research Supervisor/ Chairman DRC, Chairman, Board of Studies of the subject concerned, as the case may be, shall be communicated the name of the

external examiner to conduct the viva-voce examination. The date fixed for the viva-voce be informed to the Research Scholar and the Registrar.


- (vi) The viva-voce examination shall be conducted at the University Teaching Department in the subject or at any place fixed by the University for the purpose. The date, time and place of viva-voce examination shall be notified by the Registrar on the University Notice Board/website about a week in advance. At the time of viva-voce examination the board of examiners shall be provided with the reports of the examiners which shall be returned along with the report of viva-voce examination to the Registrar.
- (vii) The Research Scholar shall present the work embodied in the thesis before the board of examiners, members of faculty, research scholars and other interested persons. After the presentation of the research work the Board shall ask question together with those questions which have been given along with examiners reports. Others in the audience can also ask questions and the Research Scholar shall reply only those questions which are permitted by the external examiner.


22. If the examiners recommend that the Research Scholar be asked to revise/improve his/her thesis, the Vice Chancellor shall permit the Research Scholar to resubmit his/her thesis not earlier than six months and not later than eighteen months, the period being counted from the date of the issue of order to the Research Scholar. The Research Scholar shall be provided examiner (s) reports without disclosing the names of the examiners to enable him/her to improve the thesis. All the copies of the thesis shall also be returned to the Research Scholar.
- In case the Research Scholar is allowed to resubmit the thesis he/she will have to pay the prescribed fee afresh at the time of resubmission, but it shall not be necessary for him to reproduce any certificate of further attendance at the Research Centre at which he/she carried out the work.


22.1. The resubmitted five (05) copies of the thesis must mark clear mention that it is a revised version.

22.2. The thesis shall be got examined as far as possible by the examiners who finally recommended for the revision.

22.3. In case both the examiners of revised thesis accept the thesis for the award then the Research Scholar shall be awarded with the Ph.D. Degree on successful viva-voce examination as per provisions of the Ordinance.



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

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22.4 If the revised thesis is required to be revised a second time, it shall automatically stand rejected.

23. After the viva-voce, the recommendation of the examiners shall be reported to the Executive Council for the award of Ph.D. Degree to the Research Scholar.
24. No Research Scholar shall join any other course, study or appear at any other examination conducted by any university leading to a degree (except Certificate/Diploma course of Languages, Research Methodology, Statistics, Computer courses).
25. The Research Scholar, if so desires, is allowed to publish his/her thesis. However, such publication shall state on the title page itself that this was a thesis approved for the award of the Ph.D. Degree of the University.
26. The University agrees that a Research Scholar is the owner of the copyright in his/her thesis. (Appendix-13)
27. One copy of the thesis will be kept in the University Library and another copy will be kept in the Departmental Library of the concerned Research Centre was carried out; the third will be returned to the Research Supervisor.
28. After the notification for award of Ph.D. is issued (Appendix-14), the successful Research Scholars may be provided with the copies of reports of examiners, who recommended for the award of the degree, on payment of the prescribed fee. The reports will not disclose the identity of the examiners.
29. The candidates who have been already registered for Ph.D. Degree under the repealed Ordinance will continue to be governed by the Provisions of the repealed Ordinance, or they can opt to be governed from the provisions of this ordinance. The candidates who have applied for registration but have not been registered till this Ordinance comes into force shall be governed by the provisions of this Ordinance.
30. On detection of any irregularity, the University shall take suitable steps to withdraw the degree as per provisions of section 5 (11) of the Adhiniyam.



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
Clarification for part-Time Ph.D.

1. Eligibility for Part-time Research Scholars

- a. A permanent/regular teaching faculty of any Higher Education Institution (HEI), provided s/he justifies the need for a such degree and duly endorsed by the parent institution, clearly stating that the faculty shall be permitted for leaves as per need of the program.
- b. A permanent government servant, not below the rank of the group 'B' services (as defined by the State Govt./DoPT), provided s/he justifies the need for such a degree and his/her application is duly endorsed by the parent institution, clearly stating that the employee shall be permitted leave as per need of the program.
- c. Candidates from industries/Corporate sector:
 - i. The Industry/Corporate sector should have been duly approved by the concerned Regulatory Body e.g., FSSAI, ICAR, GMP, etc.
 - ii. The candidate should have completed a minimum of five years of permanent/regular service in the same organization, not below the rank of group 'B' government services.
 - iii. Justification for the need for such a degree in organizational/societal advancement.
 - iv. Till completion of the Ph.D., the candidate has to work in the same organization if s/he leaves the organization during the program, her/his admission shall be canceled.
 - v. Any IPR arising out of the work shall be the sole proprietary of the IGNTU.
- i. Three years of working experience as sub-editor/staff reporter/ correspondent or senior editorial position in ABC accredited newspapers or experience of journalism of the above mentioned or equivalent capacity from digital editions/news portals of the ABC accredited newspapers. The newspaper/digital editions/news portals must have been uninterruptedly and regularly under publication for a period of not less than thirty-six (36) months. Experience from House periodicals, souvenir annual periodicals, bi-monthlies, quarterlies, social media sites, non-recognized portals and second edition of any periodical will not be considered.
- ii. Three years of working experience as editorial crew/staff reporter or senior editorial position in ABC satellite news channels. The news channel must have been uninterruptedly and regularly under operation and on air for a period of not less than thirty-six (36) months. Experience from House periodicals, souvenir annual periodicals, bi-monthlies, quarterlies and second edition of any periodical will not be considered.
- iii. Three years of working experience as content editor/presenter/ announcer/ anchor, or senior position in creative section in recognized Radio station. The Radio station must be operational and available for listeners for a period of not less than thirty-six (36) months.
- iv. Three years of working experience in any central government or state government media organization/ government organization/PSUs/ Autonomous bodies as not less than class B employee.

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- v. Three years of working experience in creative section of advertising/PR agency accredited by INS or similar body/Central Bureau of Communication. The agency must be in operation for a period of not less than thirty-six (36) months.
 - vi. A recognized film/documentary film maker with evidence of certification and release/public exhibition of at least one film/documentary film produced/directed/contributed as creative member.
 - vii. Justification for the need for such a degree in organizational/societal advancement.
 - viii. Any IPR arising out of the work shall be the sole proprietary of the KTUJM
2. The admission of Part-Time candidates shall be governed by the then-applicable UGC and KTUJM regulations e.g., UGC Ph.D. Regulations-2022 and IGNTU Ph.D. Regulations 2023. That is -
- a. Admission to such candidates shall be only through the Research Entrance Test (VRET) or exempted category as specified in the regulations. No direct admission or any specific quota shall be entertained.
